円覚寺

- Enkakuji-temple was built by the 8th Shikken (regent) 北条時宗 (Hojo Tokimune), who effectively protected Japan against the invasion by the Mongolian army in the 13th century.

建長寺

- Kenchoji Temple is the most prestigious Zen temple in Kamakuwa, built by the 5th Shikken (regent).

鶴岡八幡宮

- Tsuruga-Oka Hachimangu shrine was built for the worshippers of the Hachiman who is the god of war like Mars.





The Assassination

- The third Shogun of the Kamakura bakufu, Minamoto-no Sanetoma was killed by Monk Kugyo, his nephew here.

鎌倉大仏 Giant Buddha

- The Giant Buddha was built in the Kamakura era







長谷寺

- Hase-Kannon is another popular temple for its giant Kannon statue.



The Sacred Place

- The Train Crossing near the Kamakura HS (鎌倉高校前) is the sacred place of the famous Japanese Manga “Slum Dunk”, visited by many Japanese and foreign worshippers.

江の島

- **Enoshima** is a small peninsula connected the land of Kamakura, which is a very popular spot where the visitors conclude their trip.

1. Traditional

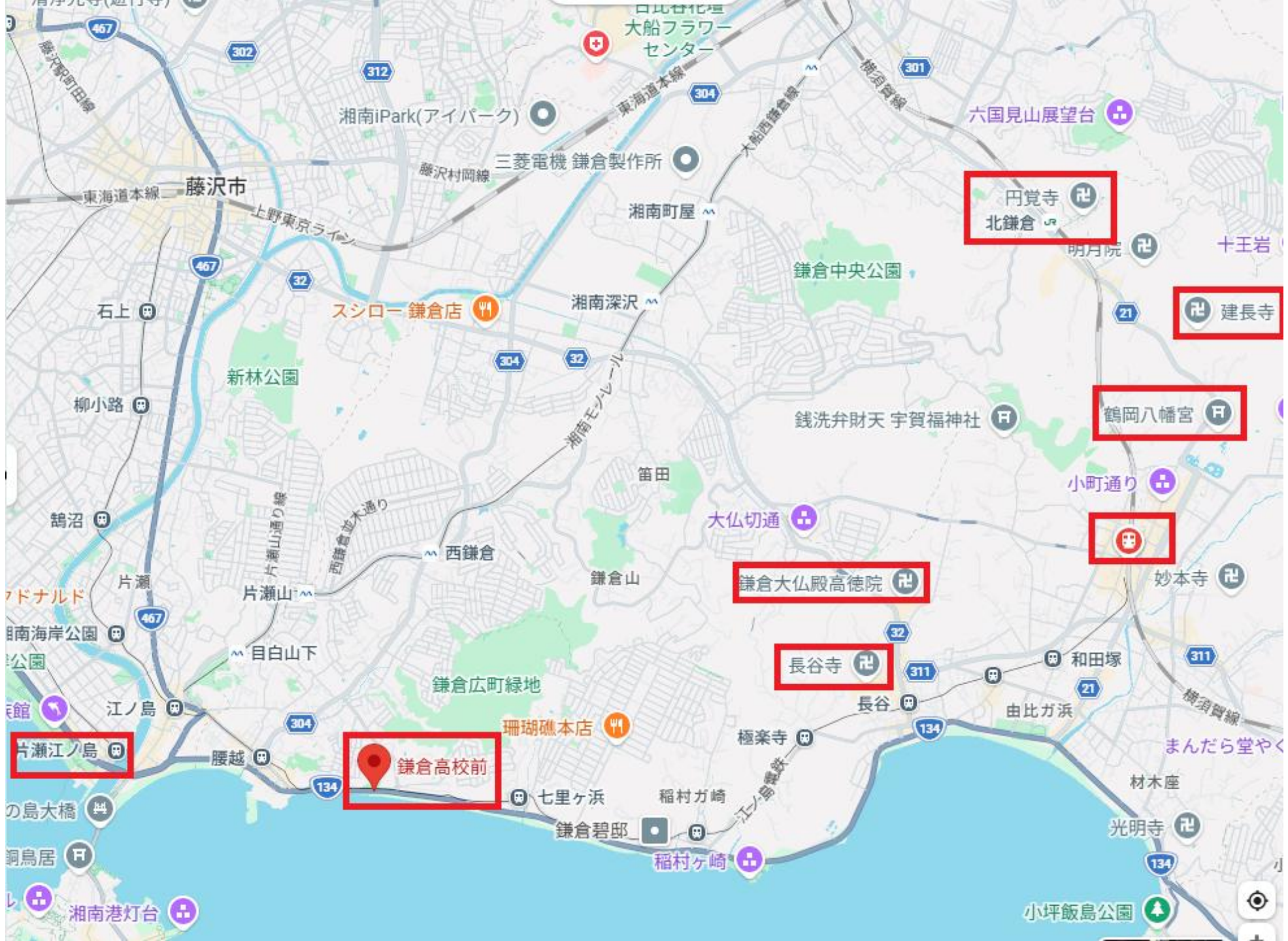

Kitakamakura St>Enkakuji>Kenchoji>(bus or walk)>Tsurugaoka Hachimangu>Kamakura St>(bus)>Daibutsu & Hase Kannon>(bus or Enoden)>Kamakura or Fujisawa

2. Route to avoid congestion

藤沢駅→バスまたは江ノ電→大仏前→長谷観音→江ノ電→鎌倉駅→鶴岡八幡宮→バスまたは歩き→建長寺→円覚寺→北鎌倉駅

Fujisawa St>(bus or Enoden)>Daibutsu & Hase Kannon>Enoden>Kamakura St>Tsurugaoka Hanchimangu>(bus or walk)>Kenchoji>Enkakuji>Kitakamakura St
